Extra Credit Options

Occasionally there will be opportunities for extra credit throughout the year. These are designed to provide a little help for those who need it, incentive to bring things to share, and credit for students who go above and beyond the classroom requirements.

You can earn up to **10 bonus points per quarter** (9 weeks). The following options are some ways you can get extra credit in Spanish class.

Earned extra credit

- **Conversación:** Online conversations in Spanish – If you have a conversation in Spanish online, you can print it out and turn it in for up to 10 bonus points.
- **Presentación:** Presentations to the class – Relevant topics can be presented to the class for up to 10 bonus points. These presentations must be prearranged and approved by the teacher.
- **Práctica:**
 - Classzone.com – This is the companion website to the *Avancemos* textbook. There are games, activities, videos, and other resources.
 - Quia.com - Worksheets, quizzes, tests, and other learning activities can be accessed at quia.com/shared/spanish.
 - You can print and turn in activities that you have completed for up to 10 bonus points. Points depend on the length and difficulty of the activity and accuracy. Acceptable topics include vocabulary, grammar, and culture that have been studied during the same quarter for which the extra credit is to be used.

Fiesta days extra credit

On *fiesta* days you can bring food to share with the class and earn extra credit.

- Homemade food (preferably Hispanic) prepared by you (5 bonus points)
- Store bought food (preferably Hispanic) (3 bonus points)
- Help clean up after the *fiesta* the last 10 minutes of class (3 points)
 - throw away all the garbage
 - wash and dry dishes and serving utensils
 - clean, rearrange, and generally tidy the classroom
